

Alternate ROOTS Resources for Social Change Facilitator/Mentor

The Community/Artists Partnership Program (CAPP) supports and promotes community-based projects between artist-activists and their community partner(s) by providing resources of information, funds and training. Initiated in 1993, CAPP was one of the first programs in the United States to promote equitable partnerships in arts-based community work. Through the CAPP program annual CAPP grants are awarded that support and promote community-based residencies by providing resources of information, funds, and training to foster and support collaborations between artists and community-based organizations. CAPP Projects are supported by a Project Mentor to help anchor the project. This Mentor is someone who brings experience working in and with communities, and can bring a wealth of knowledge to the CAPP Project. The following list is intended as a suggested place to begin identifying potential Mentors. However, you may have someone with your respective community that you know can bring guidance and direction to your project.
